



Immediate Life Support Recertification Course Regulations 2011

Please note: These regulations should be read in conjunction with the standard ILS Course Regulations

1. General

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| 1.1 | All Course Directors, Instructors and Instructor Candidates must abide by the Resuscitation Council (UK) Code of Conduct. |
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2. Pre-course Organisation

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| 2.1 | The maximum number of candidates per course is 30 . |
| 2.2 | All candidates must have a current edition of the ILS manual. If a candidate does not have a manual, the course centre must provide them with a copy of the manual purchased from the Resuscitation Council (UK). |
| 2.3 | Assessment forms and manuals for candidates who do not have a copy must be forwarded to the candidates at least 2 weeks before the course. |
| 2.4 | The Course Director is responsible for checking the candidates' ILS certificates. |

3. Candidate Eligibility and Certification

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| 3.1 | Only candidates who have successfully completed the ILS course can attend an ILS recertification course. |
| 3.2 | ALS Providers who hold a current ALS Provider certificate may obtain ILS certification by attending an ILS recertification course. The course centre must ensure that these candidates receive the ILS manual and assessment forms at least 2 weeks before the course. |
| 3.3 | Candidates may only attend the ILS recertification course within one year of the expiry date of their current ILS certificate. |
| 3.4 | Candidates are not permitted to re-certify by joining part of a standard one-day ILS course. |
| 3.5 | If the candidate is unable to show evidence of successfully completing an ILS course or cannot provide evidence of current ALS certification, they cannot attend the ILS re-certification course and must complete the full ILS Course. |
| 3.6 | Candidates cannot be considered for ILS Instructor training if they attend the ILS re-certification course. |
| 3.7 | Candidates cannot successfully complete the course unless they are present for the entire half day. |
| 3.8 | Candidates who successfully complete the course will receive a Resuscitation Council certificate. The ILS certificate is valid for 1 year . |

4. Programme, Lectures, Skill Stations and Assessment	
4.1	The ILS recertification course must adhere to the standard programme.
4.2	The same course organisation, lectures/skill stations and assessment regulations for the ILS course apply to the recertification course (see the relevant sections of the standard ILS Course Regulations)
4.3	All faculty teaching on the recertification course must be ALS Instructors or Instructor Candidates, ILS Instructors or EPLS/NLS Instructors who are also ALS Providers. There must be at least one ALS Instructor. For further details regarding faculty requirements, please see the relevant section of the standard ILS Course Regulations.
4.4	ILS Instructors may not recertify on the ILS recertification course.

5. Post-Course Organisation	
5.1	Course results must be submitted to the Resuscitation Council (UK) using the online recertification course returns form.
5.2	Certificates will be issued in the usual way as per the standard ILS Course Regulations.
